



JOURNEY WITH ALPHABETS GRADE PRIMARY

Head out on an adventure outside and practice your alphabet skills with this nature based activity.

WHAT YOU'LL LEARN:

- New vocabulary
- Improve descriptive language
- Enhance observation skills
- Calm excited students with this activity

CURRICULUM OUTCOMES:

- Play based learning that enhances curiosity, learners learn through discovery and invention and promote language and communication
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MATERIALS:

- One worksheet, per child
- Pencil
- Clipboard

This is an individual or group outdoor activity, it can be done in outdoor spaces of the school, home, backyard, or nearby parks/trails.

WHAT TO DO:

- Hand over worksheets to the students
- Demonstrate the activity (see worksheet below) and give examples in detail about what needs to be done to complete the activity. Demonstrate that anything that you can see, touch, or smell can be noted in the sheet in

connections with the starting alphabets. For example, you could say that, during our nature walk, if you see a tree, you should write the spelling of a tree in front of the alphabet T or simply draw tree. You can connect the same with phonic sounds. For example, if you are feeling cold while walking, you could draw how are you feeling next to the letter C or write the word 'cold'. If you see students play, you could draw their play or write play next to the letter P, if the students are laughing, you can draw laughing face in front of letter L.

- Take the time to have a class reflection on how the activity went. Students can reflect on their learning and share their work with fellow students.

ASSESSMENT:

- You can check the activity sheet to evaluate learner's performance. Learners curiosity and creativity can be noted by their performance during the nature walk

EXTENSION:

- Learners can be encouraged to demonstrate their understanding of alphabets in real world by connecting the alphabets with day to day things and activities, emotions and senses at home, outside, in the garden to enhance their learning and further built their confidence and communication skills
